**PLAINTIFF’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AWARD OF ATTORNEYS’ FEES,  
COSTS AND EXPENSES, SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATOR’S COSTS, AND  
CLASS REPRESENTATIVE’S SERVICE AWARD**

TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT Plaintiff, Lisa Holt, by counsel (“Plaintiff” or “Class Representative”), under Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 23(h) and 54(d)(2), hereby moves the Court for entry of an Order:

1. Awarding Class Counsel attorneys’ fees from the Settlement Fund in the amount of \$1,026,145.33, which represents one-third of the Value of the Settlement;
2. Approving reimbursement from the Settlement Fund of costs and expenses to Class Counsel in the amount of \$12,286.08;
3. Approving reimbursement from the Settlement Fund of costs to the Settlement Administrator in an amount up to \$62,500.00; and
4. Awarding from the Settlement Fund a service award to the Class Representative, in recognition of the Class Representative’s role in securing the benefits of the Settlement for the Classes, in the amount of \$10,000.00.

This motion is made on the grounds that the requested amounts are consistent with the Settlement Agreement, are the product of arm's-length negotiations by informed counsel, are well within the amounts routinely awarded by courts in the Eighth Circuit, and are fair, reasonable, and adequate in light of the value of the Settlement being \$3,078,436. Defendant does not oppose the motion. This motion is accompanied by suggestions in support of the motion, the Declaration of Lynn A. Toops in support of the motion (Ex. 1 hereto), and a proposed order granting the motion (Ex. 2 hereto).
